



MORIN, Jean-Paul, B.Com., Ph D.
1920 – 2012

On August 24, 2012, in Montreal, Mr. Jean-Paul Morin died at the age of 91. He was the founder of LaSalle College, an international teaching institution specialized, among others, in fashion and hotel management and tourism.

Mr. Morin was very active in his community as well as the world of business and served in many organizations such as the Chamber of Commerce of LaSalle, the LaSalle Hospital Foundation, the Mouvement Desjardins, the Caisse populaire and the parish of Notre-Dame-du-Sacré-Coeur of LaSalle, HEC, and Concordia University. When he retired, he also devoted his time to an illiteracy organization, Suicide-Action Montreal and was a volunteer at the Institut de réadaptation de Montréal.

He is survived by his wife Carmen, his children Nicole, France and Paul, his grandchildren Alexandre, Frédéric and Étienne, his great-granddaughters Zoé and Béatrice, his sister Cécile and many nieces and nephews and friends.
